

Importing a Plan – from Design@Web to Winner Design

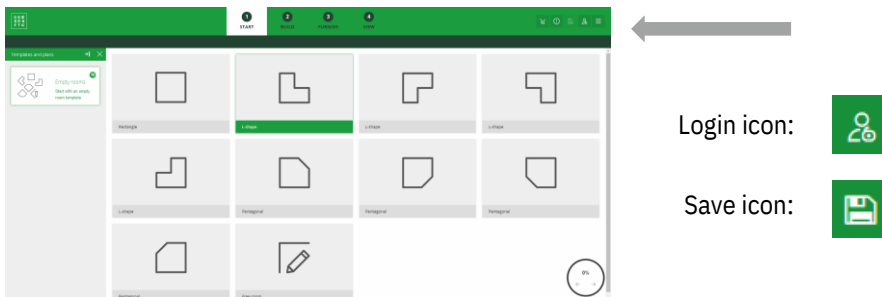
Plans created from the Design@Web tool can be imported into Winner Design. In order to import these plans, you will need the following:

1. Winner Design installed on your local machine
2. A Showcase 360 cloud account
3. Your Showcase 360 cloud login will then be configured to your Winner Design license.

Steps 2 and 3 can be checked with your Compusoft Sales Representative.

Plan in Design@Web

Click the **Kitchen Planner** link provided from Compusoft. You will now be directed to the online planning tool. To be able to import your drawing to Winner Design, you will need to Login. The Login and Save icons are located at the top right part of the screen.



1. Press **Login** and enter your registered details.
2. Plan your room
You can at this stage choose **step 3 to save** or go straight to **step 4**.
3. Click **Save** to save your plan. You will be e-mailed a PDF of this plan.

Once your plan is at **View**, you will be given the option to Finalise your plan.

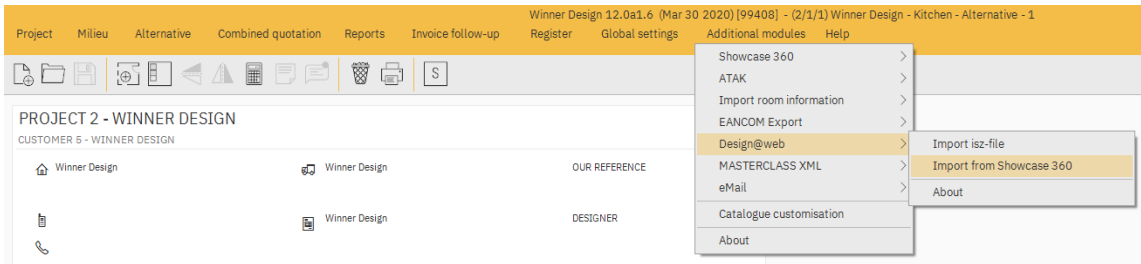

4. Click **Finalise your plan**.

The plan will be saved and will be shared to the Showcase 360 cloud account that you have been registered to. You will also receive an e-mail with the plan as a PDF.

Import into Winner Design

Now that you have saved your plan in your registered Showcase 360 cloud, you can now import it into Winner Design. Open up Winner.



There are 2 different points to access Showcase 360.

1. In the **Menu bar**, go to **Additional modules > Design@Web > Import from CS Cloud / Showcase 360**.
2. You will be informed of new plans available in the **Mail Icon** in the tool bar on the top right-hand corner. Click the icon to go directly to plans available.

Using one of these access points, the next screen will be Showcase 360. Your new plan will be in the **Plans** tab. Click on your new plan to open.

Click on **Import to current project** or **Import to new project**. The icons are in the top right of the plan window. This will create a new Alternative with the details applied in Design@Web.
